In terms of Aims 6 and 7, differences among the five distinct phenotypes identified previously in global, cancer related, and cumulative life stress and EAA using fourteen epigenetic clocks were evaluated. Moderate, High, and Very High clinical aging phenotypes had clinically meaningful levels of global stress. In terms of cancer-related stress, the mean Impact of Event Scale-Revised (IES-R) total scores for the High and Very High classes suggest clinically meaningful PTSD symptomatology and probable PTSD, respectively. Across multiple epigenetic clocks, the patterns of pairwise differences in various measures of epigenetic age among the clinical aging phenotypes were congruent with pairwise differences in chronological age. Compared to the Very Low clinical aging phenotype, the High and Very High groups had increased relative EAA acceleration estimated using the GrimAge clock. The study findings that using subjective measures of stress and objective measures of accelerated aging support the validity of the clinical aging phenotypes identified using common patient-reported outcomes assessed in clinical practice.

Abstract The purpose of this research is to investigate the influences that Information Retrieval Systems such as online Search Engines and Databases have on designers' early searching strategies. The study involves the observation of designers transforming early design language into query 'keyword' language for the operation of Information Retrieval Systems and how this transition causes a shift in early design exploration. This transformation is referred to in this research as the CLASS activity; Converting Language from Abstract Searching to Specific. Findings show a common pattern across the activity of both professional and advanced student designers. Information Retrieval Systems are seen to drive the searching process into specific, explored domains rather than stimulate an 'abstract' broad investigation. The IR systems are built upon categories that are created to manage the information content. It is these categories that require a person to use defined keywords and query sentences to operate the Information Retrieval Systems. The findings suggest that using Information Retrieval Systems prior to defining the scope of a design problem causes designers to prematurely focus on specific searching.
