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What is it?

TeachingEnglish – In-Service Teacher Development is a series of development workshops for state sector English language teachers (secondary and adult) with a B1 language competence level; L2 teachers working in the private sector and less experienced L1 teachers of English working in all sectors.

How is it delivered?

There are two components to each workshop: trainer notes and participant worksheets. A trainer guide gives trainers advice on how to prepare for course delivery and use course materials effectively. A recommended reading list is provided for each workshop.

What does the course consist of?

A series of ten teacher development workshops covering the following topics:

- Becoming a reflective practitioner (two workshops)
- Learning styles (two workshops)
- Grammar (three workshops)
- Process writing (three workshops)

Each workshop provides input on key concepts as well as practical guidance on teaching techniques and methodology.

The types of activities course participants engage in include:

- group discussions
- presentations
- quizzes
- games

The tasks and activities can be adapted for participants to use in their own classrooms. Each workshop concludes with guided activities to promote reflective practice.
