Principles and Processes

The world of ELT has seen numerous developments in terms of ideas, techniques and methodologies, and the now widespread use of digital media has added yet another dimension. Our curricula and materials have, as a result of all these developments, become much richer. However, they have also become much more complex, and this can sometimes make it difficult for teachers to see on what's really important for effective language learning. This talk will endeavour to cut through some of this complexity and identify a few core principles that should underlie everything that we do in the language classroom. Illustrative materials will show what these principles look like in practice.



Tom Hutchinson has taught English in the UK, Germany, and Croatia, and he has given teacher training courses in many other countries around the world. For a number of years he lectured at the Institute for English Language Education at Lancaster University, UK.
