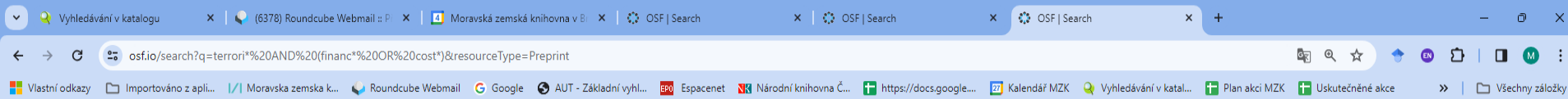

Description:

A Functional Modeling Framework (FMF) for defining and comparing models of consciousness and cognition has recently been developed. This framework proposes to have the capacity to represent the complete set of the functionality of human consciousness and cognition, which if true, would suggest that all models of consciousness and cognition can be represented within the framework. The framework also proposes to define the criteria for a model of cognition to have the potential for the general problem solving ability commonly recognized as true human intelligence. The FMF provides a single framework for defining models of consciousness and cognition that is human-centric in that the functions can be validated through experiments that can be performed within innate human self-awareness rather than being dependent on assumptions made by any specific model. This human-centric functional modeling approach is intended to enable different models of AGI to be more easily compared so research can reliably converge on a single understanding, enabling the possibility of massively collaborative interdisciplinary projects to research, and implement models of consciousness or cognition where such massive collaboration has not proved possible before. The FMF defines requirements for all the functional components defined by the framework, but leaves specific models to define their own implementations. This paper summarizes a model of cognition developed within this framework that is proposed to meet the criteria of an AGI as defined within this framework. This description is expanded in a number of other papers.

Abstract en fr

Americans are more worried about misinformation than about sexism, racism, terrorism, and climate change. Fears over misinformation on social media are overblown. Misinformation represents a minute proportion of the news that people consume online (~ 1%), and a small minority of people account for most of the misinformation consumed and shared online. People, on average, are good at detecting fake news and identifying reliable sources of information. People do not believe everything they see and read on the internet. Instead, they are active consumers of information who domesticate technologies in unexpected ways. It's very unlikely that social media exacerbates the misinformation problem, that fake news contributes to important political events or that falsehoods spread faster than the truth. Yet, some fake news stories do go viral, and understanding why, despite their inaccuracy, they go viral is important. In a series of experiments, we identified a factor that, alongside accuracy, drives the sharing of true and fake news: the 'interestingness-if-true' of a piece of news, e.g. if alcohol was a cure against COVID-19, the pandemic would end in an unprecedented international booze-up. In three experiments (N = 904), participants were more willing to share news they found more interesting-if-true, as well as news they deemed more accurate. They rated fake news less accurate but more interesting-if-true than true news. People may not share news of questionable accuracy by mistake, but instead

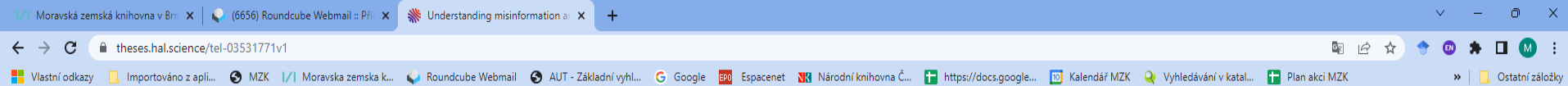

a positive impact on their attitudes towards the vaccines. In the end, people are not stupid. When provided with good arguments, they change their mind in the direction of good arguments. Most people avoid sharing misinformation because they care about their reputation. We do not live in a post-truth society in which people disregard the truth. Overall, we should probably be more concerned about the large portion of people who do not trust reliable sources and are uninformed because they do not follow the news, rather than the minority of people who trust unreliable sources and are misinformed.

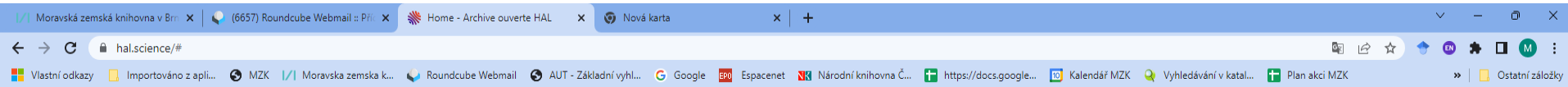

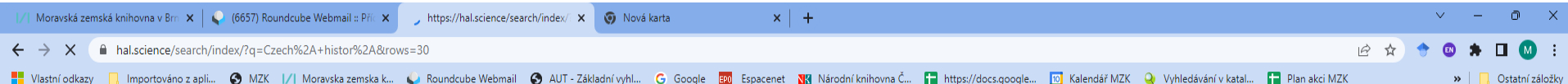

Práce se zabývá tradicí vystavování lidských „kuriozit“ v Praze a českých zemích v širším kontextu moderních diskurzů nezpůsobilosti a představ o kolektivním těle českého národa. Pražské přehlídky „liliputánů“, „obruč“, „siamských dvojčat“ a dalších „abnormit“ jsou zde zasazeny do širšího rámce vývoje zábavní kultury v Evropě od počátku 19. století. Těžiště práce spadá do období přelomu 19. a 20. století, do období rozvoje mezinárodního zábavního průmyslu na jedné straně a expertního vědění o ab/normálním na straně druhé. Jak tvrdím, přehlídky „kuriozit“ čerpaly svou popularitu především ze schopnosti artikulovat určité obavy a touhy, spojené jak s vtělenou existencí jednotlivých návštěvníků, tak s jejich představami o tělech společenských, především s imaginacemi kolektivního těla českého národa. Ve čtyřech případových studiích ukazují, jak performance „kuriozních“ těl propojovaly dobové imaginace o etnických, genderových a třídních diferencích a umožňovaly tak v různých historických kontextech reprodukovat představy o společenském řádu a mocenských hierarchiích, které se odrážely rovněž v představě kolektivního těla národa.
